This month in the church calendar, we enter the season of Lent. In just a few weeks, we'll hear the story of how Jesus laid down his life for us. As we prepare to celebrate that ultimate gift of love shown on Good Friday and the victory of Easter's empty tomb, this Lenten season of preparation offers a great opportunity for us to intentionally focus on faith as we journey towards the cross.

During our Lenten services this year, I will be using the book Turning Over Tables by Kathy Escobar as the inspiration for our messages each week. Through the pages of this book, and through the weekly readings and messages, we will be exploring the call of Jesus to put our faith into action. I hope and pray this will be both inspiring and challenging. Offering us an opportunity to explore how we may align our lives with the way of Jesus.

For our Worship services, we will be using a service created by the Nourishing Vocation Project at St. Olaf College, in Northfield, MN. It follows the VOCARE spiritual practice. Vocare is the Latin word meaning "to call." The Vocare spiritual practice invites us to reflect upon values, openness, call, attentiveness, regrets, and experiences of God's presence. As baptized children of God, we have been claimed by God, named by God, and called to be a part of bearing God's creative and redeeming Word to all the world. This liturgy invites us into reflection and contemplation to deepen our understanding of God's call upon our life and work, our labor and leisure, our being and our doing, so that we might more intentionally live life on purpose and engage in ministry on purpose for the common good.

The decision has been made to have joint Lenten services again with St. Ansgar. On ASH Wednesday, there will be a service at St. Ansgar at 3pm, and a service at Zion at 6:30pm. The rest of Lent our services will be at 6:30pm. Zion will host all the Wednesday evening services. St. Ansgar will host our Maundy Thursday service, as well as our Good Friday service; both of which will be at 6:30pm.

Please join together as the family of God in this time of meaningful contemplation and reflection on who we are, what it is God is asking of us, and what God has done for all of us through Jesus the Christ.
